Announcement Regarding Establishment of a Production Subsidiary in Brazil

KOITO MANUFACTURING CO., LTD. announces that, at the Board of Directors on September 28, 2016, it was resolved to establish a production subsidiary in Federative Republic of Brazil, as follows:

1. Objective

In South America, with its large population (approx. 400 million) and the current ratio of persons per vehicle (5.3 persons per vehicle), the automotive production is expected to increase in the medium- to long-term perspective. Above all, Brazil, having the world's fifth largest population (approx. 200 million) is a center of automobile industry where Japanese, European and American automakers locate their production bases.

A production base in Brazil will enable KOITO to better respond to the automobile market in South America that is expected to grow further. Thus, KOITO will continue making efforts to gain new businesses and improve profitability as KOITO Group by strengthening its global production structure.
